

Hunters O.I.S.

The report of the investigation of the Officer Involved Shooting last August in Hunters has been delivered to the office for review. The SIRR team, made up of detectives from several regional agencies, conducted the investigation. They have collected the physical evidence, interviewed the witnesses, gathered laboratory reports and documented everything that is humanly and reasonably possible. They produced a thorough detailed report.

The Prosecutor's office has the duty to apply the law of Washington to the facts of the situation and make a decision as to whether the use of deadly force by the officer was justified by those facts. The prosecutor can take guidance from the decision from the rulings of the Supreme Courts, both state and federal. Those decisions and the RCWs form the law of our land.

It will take about a month or so for the office to review the case file and then to write the report. I usually have one of my deputies read the file as well.

Hunting season is here and there will be many hunters in the woods and remote areas. Some hunters will only hunt on public land and private land with permission, but some will hunt without regard to where they are or whether or not they have permission. This means there will be incidents between hunters and land-

owners. Most hunters are mindful of the rights of local folks and make sure they know where they are and ask before they enter on private land, but some don't care where they are when they hunt.

During this season there are also some folks who mix hunting and drinking. This usually does not turn out very well. Accidents happen when liquor and guns are mixed and people are mistaken for game with tragic results. Nearly every year we read of tragic incidents where people are killed putting guns away or handling them. Sometimes a hunting partner is the victim.

Please practice hunting and gun safety. Wear hunters orange anytime you are in the woods during these weeks. Unload your weapons completely before you put them in the vehicle. Enjoy the outdoors and the woods and the mountains. But don't take chances with anyone's life or your own.
