time. Locations will be announced on the Libraries of Stevens County Facebook page.

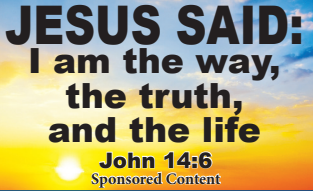
