Local father and son team featured in the upcoming documentary FINDING NOAH, being shown one night only on Oct 8th in over 650 theaters nationwide!

Bill and Will Hughes (Chattaroy, WA) were part of a team of archeologists, mountaineers, theologians, and local Kurds that explored MT Ararat in 2012 and 2013.

For over 2,000 years, man has been searching for the final resting place of Noah's Ark. Though there have been many attempts, few have been able to fully explore the one place specifically noted in the Bible: Mount Ararat. Located in Eastern Turkey, Agri Dagh or "The Painful Mountain" is the tallest mountain in the region and lies in the very center of a centuries old, geo-politically unstable hot spot. With constant threats of deadly rock slides, hidden crevasses, and glacial ice falls, the Kurdish Rebel held mountain poses great risk to any explorer, let alone those performing a thorough scientific investigation.

tude environment. On the 2013 dig, under instruction by geophysicists and archeologists Bill and Will along with native Texan Bruce Hall, spent 30 days at nearly 17,000 feet drilling exploratory holes into the huge glacier in hopes of locating evidence of the ancient craft. Bill, a retired USAF Lt. Col., used well what he learned about Arctic Survival while as-

signed to the USAF Survival School at Fairchild AFB, Spokane. On both expeditions he and his son Will were the first to the summit, last off the mountain, and fully embodied the spirit of adventure, dedication, and faith! Go to www.findingnoah.com for more information and tickets.
