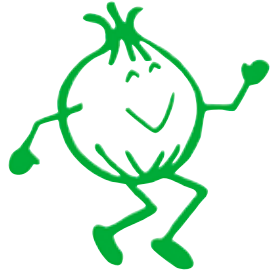

# Two Days Of Free Family Fun On Nov 10-11, 2018

## The 23rd Annual Fall Folk Festival Celebrates Cultural Diversity

**Spokane, WA** - The 23rd annual Spokane Folklore Society Fall Folk Festival on November 10 and 11 is free to the public and features 7 stages of traditional and ethnic dance, music, workshops, special entertainment, crafts for children, and jamming. Approximately 5,000 people attend the festival annually which is held at the Spokane Community College Lair. The festival supports regional folk musicians, local folk artists who are hidden gems well worth discovering. The festival presents about 100 performing groups representing Celtic, blue- grass, blues, African, Asian, Middle Eastern traditions, and more.

Also featured are sales of traditional crafts. A live KPBX Radio show is one of Saturday's highlights. A traditional New England Contra dance will close the festival on Saturday and Sunday. Meals and snacks are available in the college cafeteria, and baked goods and coffee at the Festival bake sale.

This community event is supported by several hundred volunteers working the days of the festival and through donations from sponsors, individuals, and \$5 buttons at the Festival. The festival needs about \$20,000 dollars to produce the festival and pay for rent, sound equipment, craft supplies, publicity, printing, security and required building staff. All performers and festival organizers donate their time.

Through the years community businesses, organizations, and individuals have generously supported this event. Our 2016 major sponsors include Avista Foundation, Inlander, Spokane Community College, City of Spokane Cultural Grant, and Washington State Arts Commission. # 255 Dogs Rescued

The Stevens County Sheriff has seized 255 dogs from two puppy mills operating in the county. I say seize, but really it was a rescue. The majority of dogs are Chihuahuas.

I have received preliminary reports of the investigation and will receive more supplemental reports as the investigation continues. There are still aspects of the situation which remain unexplored and the investigation will continue.

There were two locations involved. One is near Tum Tum and the other is in the Suncrest area. From the reports it is obvious that the animals were kept in conditions that are criminal. In one location, 90 dogs were located. The majority were living in a mobile home with two people. There was apparently no water or plumbing on the property as well. At one location there was a skeletonized carcass believed to be that of a dog.

All of these animals have all been placed into a clean environment and have received medical evaluations

and treatment. Nearly all the animals were suffering from some medical malady or another. One animal was deemed too ill to survive by the veterinarian and humanely destroyed.

The county does not have the resources to deal with a problem of this size, but thankfully, we are not alone. Literally dozens of volunteers from several agencies and groups are helping. They are caring for the animals and making plans to assist in finding suitable place for these dogs. We would not be able to deal with this without them. If you see some new folks in town with animal rescue T shirts, tell them thanks.

We will be making charging decisions soon. I am certain there will be misdemeanor and felony charges, but the number and type of charges are uncertain at this time. I have assigned Deputy Prosecutor Erika George to handle these cases.

# Quilt show at railroad museum



Quilters and railfans alike will enjoy a special weekend October 5-6-7 when the Inland Northwest Rail Museum sponsors a quilt show from 11 am-4 pm all three days. It's a chance to learn railroad history, take a train ride, tour the museum and view the quilts on display. A special admission of \$6 is being offered for everything!

This is the first annual quilt show event at the museum and initial response has been overwhelming. The quilt show is for fun!...no entry fees, no categories, no limit for entries. Visitors will pick their favorites resulting in People's Choice Awards of \$100 for first, \$50 second and \$25 third. Quilts will be on display throughout the museum so you will be able to learn Inland Northwest Railroad History as you wander throughout the building looking at quilts.

The museum celebrated its second anniversary in August marked by new exhibits and tours of rail cars. Over 6,000 people visited the museum in 2017 and more are expected this year. Visitors hail from virtually every state with many railfans from England, Germany, Norway, Australia, Canada, France, New Zealand, and other countries throughout the world.

The museum specializes in preserving the history of Inland Northwest railroads. Rail cars and hundreds of pieces of memorabilia are on display. Gone are familiar railroad names like Great Northern, Northern Pacific, Spokane, Portland & Seattle, Central Washington, Spokane International, Milwaukee and many branch lines. Years of mergers and failures by area railroads are concentrated in the present day Union Pacific and Burlington Northern Sante Fe Railroads. Histories of each of those original railroads are on display at the museum in addition to the last existing Spokane streetcar.

Normally open 10 am-5 pm, Friday-Sunday the museum's season runs from April 1st to December 15th. ## 2018 Campfire Ban Lifted At Lake Roosevelt National Recreation Area

Effective immediately, campfires are allowed in established fire rings in campgrounds and day-use areas and on lake shores below the high water mark throughout Lake Roosevelt National Recreation Area. Charcoal grills are also allowed at this time.

Please remember that regulations require your campfire to be less than three feet in diameter within the established fire ring. Fires must be attended at all times and completely extinguished with water before you go to bed or leave your campsite. It is also illegal to burn chemically treated wood, painted wood, wood with staples as well as household garbage including plastic and cans.

# Stevens County Treasurer Leslie Valz seeks Re-Election

**How has your experience prepared you for this position?**

**Leslie Valz:** I have years of experience managing large (hundreds) to small teams of employees. # Questions For Pend Oreille Sheriff Candidates

To the editor,

I have two questions for the candidates running for county sheriff. The first is what will you do to prevent your deputies from shooting one of us citizens if we are stopped for a minor traffic violation? I am talking about the use of deadly force because the deputy is fearful for his life. The deputy is by himself and at night. He can't see what the driver is doing or not doing and must be prepared to defend himself if a threat is perceived. On the other hand I don't deserve the death penalty for a burned out taillight. I will be unarmed, be respectful and follow the deputy's lawful instructions. Hopefully the deputies will have body cameras, but I have seen videos of unarmed citizens being killed by police officers during traf-

fic stops. Please don't hire or retain any deputies that are so afraid that they go right to deadly force as the first and only option. Some videos show the deputy escalating the situation into deadly force. Perhaps consider a policy where the deputy approaches and goes back to the safety of his car and waits for backup if he doesn't feel safe.

The second question is about catching and arresting the thieves in our community. I realize that many of them are stealing for drug money and are a huge financial liability for the county to jail and run through our courts. Those of us who have been their victims of burglary want justice, but it seems that the county can't afford to make the arrest. Often the theft investigation has been limited to a report

filed for the insurance claim.

I hope that our sheriff candidates can provide creative solutions to these two questions as our lives and property are at stake.

Mr. Scobby,

Thank you for the opportunity to address the important issues you raised in your open letter. First of all, I would like to say that all of the deputies employed by the Sheriff's Office are well trained. Every deputy goes through an extensive background check and psychological assessment prior to employment. Only those of the highest quality are offered employment. I have 100% confidence in every deputy employed by the

Sheriff's Office. They routinely face high stress situations in their daily duties, and their performance in those situations show their character. There has not been any incident in Pend Oreille County of their conduct escalating to the level you described during a traffic stop or any other citizen contact. As you know Law Enforcement can be a dangerous profession where split second decisions must be made.

A short answer to your first question on preventing deputies from shooting a person during a traffic stop is: continued training.

There is a popular expression among law enforcement of all kinds and that is to "train until its second nature." Training based on real-world scenarios is crucial to giving the deputies a chance to ponder a situation they might find themselves in before they are exposed to them in a real-world situation. This allows

the deputies to be familiar with their decision-making process and to learn to expect possible outcomes. Training methods available nowadays can be fully immersive to where all of your senses are engaged. So much so that sometimes it seems "realer than real." Having experienced this training myself, I know this is an incredibly valuable tool toward helping deputies in their duties.

To your point of the deputy waiting for backup, while this is an ideal situation, it is not always possible to await an additional unit. This scenario is also covered in training scenarios.

The various training options open to Sheriff's deputies all serve to not make deadly force the first option for a deputy. The one thing deputies do not control during any contact with the public is the community member's cooperation and actions. Just as you mentioned, you will

be cooperative and follow the deputy's instructions. This is the best course of action in every single circumstance whenever there is contact between a deputy and a community member. That having been said, in the event deadly force is utilized, a fair and measured assessment of the entire situation and everyone's behavior will be conducted. If any wrongdoing is found, it will be dealt with in a timely manner and in accordance with the law.

Per your second question, stopping burglaries, thefts, and any other attempts to deprive a person of their property is high on my list of goals for the administration once I am Sheriff. As you said, the drug trade is fueling this property crime epidemic. It must be addressed, or we can expect little to no progress with the thefts and other drug related crimes. In regard to the thefts and property crimes,


